Firmware updates on HP printers may block aftermarket cartridges. If your printer is connected to the internet, most new firmware versions released by HP may automatically be installed onto your printer without any previous notifications or permission requests.

Follow the steps below to learn how to disable the automatic firmware updates and avoid having your aftermarket cartridge blocked from functioning.

Step 1:
On the printer screen, select the Setup option, then select Service.





Step 2:

Select LaserJet Update:

If an information paragraph should appear, click NEXT





Step 3: Select Manage Updates:



Step 4: Click Allow Updates and select No:





This will return you to the Manage Updates screen.

Step 5:
Select Prompt Before Install and click Always Prompt.





This will return you to the **Manage Updates** screen.

Select Check Automatically and click Off.





You have now successfully disabled the automatic firmware updates in your printer.

Note that printer interfaces can vary between different models, so prompts may be displayed in a different order, but the instructions are generally the same across models from these series printers. For more information, reach out directly to your sales representative.
